Hi everyone,

Here it is the beginning of March and spring is fast approaching. As I rode around the community today, the landscapers were finishing up and things looked pretty good. I know they did a drastic cut on some shrubs, but this had to be done to encourage new growth. In the next couple of months, we plan on replacing some of the dead or missing plants.

As most people have noticed, the police are back and will be giving out tickets for speeding, not stopping at stop signs, or other infractions. This is not a one-time deal. They will be coming back periodically in the upcoming months. A number of people in our community had enough and sought the help of the mayor's office.

At the march meeting we will be talking and voting on a mandatory painting deadline of all units. Right now, we are talking of May of 2012, which gives everyone almost a year to save up. Any unit painted in the last four years will be exempt, but will have to have a clean roof. Talking of roofs, we have about thirty that have not been cleaned yet, but hope to have them done by April. I think the 2012 painting deadline is fair since all units will be ten or more years old.

#### City of Delray Beach Municipal Election— Tuesday, March 8, 2011

The City of Delray Beach will hold its Non-Partisan Municipal Election on Tuesday, March 8, 2011, to fill three (3) seats of the City's five member Commission. Residents will elect a Mayor and two (2) City Commissioners, each serving two-year terms. All terms commence on March 31, 2011.

Should a tie occur between the top two candidates for any seat, a Second Non-Partisan Election will be held on Tuesday, March 22, 2011.

Following the election, the City Commission will hold its Annual Organizational Meeting on Thursday, March 31st, at 6:00 pm in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 100 NW 1st Avenue. During this meeting, all newly elected (and re-elected)

Commissioners with take an oath of office and be sworn into office.

**VOTER REGISTRATION:** The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections will close voter registration on Monday, February 7, 2011 at 5:00 pm for the March 8th Election. To register, obtain a voter registration application (either in person or by telephone) from the Supervisor of Elections main office, 240 South Military Trail, West Palm Beach, (561) 656-6200. Applications are also available at the Delray Beach City Clerk's Office, 100 NW 1st Avenue, Delray Beach and online at *www.pbcelections.org*.

**VOTER IDENTIFICATION:** Upon entering the polling location, registered voters will be required to present a valid picture ID. If the picture identification does not contain the signature of the voter, additional identification with the voter's signature shall be required. For a list of acceptable forms of identification, visit *www.mydelraybeach.com* and select *City Clerk* under *Departments*.

**ABSENTEE BALLOT:** For information or to obtain an absentee ballot, contact the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections at (561) 276-1226 (Delray Beach) or (561) 656-6200 (West Palm Beach).

**POLLING LOCATIONS:** Polling locations in the City of Delray Beach will be open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on Election Day.
