Hope everyone has been well. Fall has arrived, but our summer problems have not gone away. Last month, I talked about a rash of car and house break-ins in our community. We continue to have the same problems so all residents must be diligent in locking your houses and cars. We wouldn't be having continued break-ins if everyone was following this advice. Also, every house has a burglar alarm so please use it. There is only so much security we can provide. You must help yourself!

On another note, letters have gone out about the November board election, which will be a little different from previous years. On the advice of our lawyer, all nominations will come from the floor on the day of the elections, which is Sat., November 5th. Sign in will begin at about 12:15 PM and the doors will be locked at 1 PM sharp. Please make every effort to be prompt.

As of this writing, the Board is deciding what kind of gate system we will be installing. As everyone knows, we have had trouble with the present system. The system is old and is constantly breaking down. What ever system we decide on will be different from what we have now. We will be able to invalidate the cards of people who have moved out of our community.

Just a little reminder, May 31, 2012 is coming closer and you must have your house painted. We have some prices from one contractor which amounts to \$2400 for a quad (it breaks down to \$700 for outside units and \$500 for the two inside units). For the two unit homes, it is \$900 per house. In all cases, the total unit must be painted for these prices. If you have painted, please notify Bob Loperfido so he can make note of it.

We will have a special meeting right before our regular October meeting to vote on the budget. As of right now, monthly assessments will go up \$8 a month.

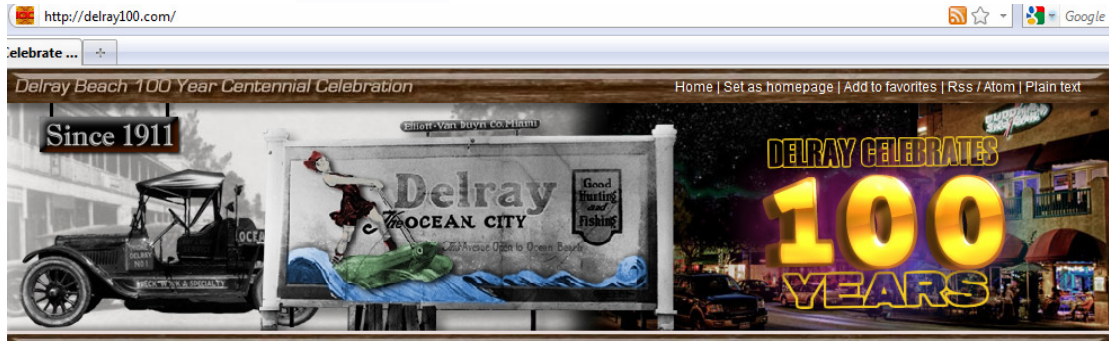

**Celebrate Delray's Centennial - 1911 - 2011
100 Year All American Journey!**

October 9, 1911, was a very significant date for the Town of Delray. In the previous month on September 4, 1911, a public meeting had been held at the Ladies Improvement Association Hall to discuss a vote for incorporation. The proposal of the new name change was due to the need for new luck and hoped that this new name would bring them prosperity. On October 9th, the chosen date, 57 qualified electors voted with the result that 56 approved and 1 abstained. The Town was now Incorporated and named officially changed to the Town of Delray from Linton. It was an amazing turning point, a new beginning for Delray and improvements began immediately! If only the settlers could see Delray today!!!
